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**What Is This Action About?** The Action alleges that, on or about May 24, 2024, Advance Auto Parts, Inc. and Advance Stores Company, Incorporated (collectively "Defendant") became aware that it was the victim of a Data Incident involving its cloud computing software company that housed Private Information belonging to Defendants' employees and candidates for employment. On July 10, 2024, Defendant began notifying individuals who sought employment with Defendants for the employees, and current employees that their information may have been involved in the Data Incident. Defendants deny any wrongdoing whatsoever. No court has ever found that Defendant has any liability for the Data Incident.

**Who Is A Settlement Class Member?** You are a Settlement Class Member if you are a person in the United States whose Private Information was potentially compromised as a result of the Data Incident and who were sent notice of the Data Incident.

**How To Receive a Settlement Class Member Benefit?** To receive a Settlement Class Member Benefit from the \$10,000,000 non-reversionary Settlement Fund, you must complete and submit a Claim Form online at [www.website.com](http://www.website.com) or by mail to Advance Auto Data Incident Action, c/o [Settlement Administrator's Address]. Settlement Class Members may choose to receive an electronic payment by visiting [www.website.com](http://www.website.com). Settlement Benefits include the reimbursement of up to \$5,000 for document losses resulting from the Data Incident, and/or \$100 for California Class Members under the California Consumer Privacy Act, and/or two years of Kroll Essential Monitoring credit and identity monitoring or an estimated \$100 Alternative Cash Payment (subject to pro rata increase or decrease).

### What Are My Other Rights?

- **Do Nothing:** You will be a Settlement Class Member and will automatically receive a Settlement Class Member Benefit if you file a claim for a benefit. You give up your rights to sue Defendants or bring any other lawsuit against Defendant or the Released Parties, as defined in the Settlement Agreement, for the same claims.
- **Exclude yourself:** You can opt out of the Settlement and keep your right to sue about the claims in this Action, but you will not get a Settlement Class Member Benefit. You must submit a valid and timely request to opt-out at [www.website.com](http://www.website.com) or by mail to the Settlement Administrator by << end of the Opt-Out Period >>.
- **Object:** You can stay in the Settlement but tell the Court why you think the Settlement should not be approved. Your written objection with all required contents can be mailed, with a **postmark date no later than <<end of the Objection Period>>**, to the Settlement Administrator, or completed online at [www.website.com](http://www.website.com). You may also request to appear at the Final Approval Hearing. Detailed instructions on how to exclude yourself, object, or appear at the hearing can be found on the Long Form Notice found on the Settlement Website.

**Do I have a Lawyer?** Yes, the Court has appointed J. Devlan Geddes, Goetz, Geddes & Gardner P.C.; Raphael Graybill, Graybill Law Firm, PC; John Heenan, Heenan & Cook, PLLC; Amy Keller, DiCello Levitt LLP; and Jason S. Rathod, Migliaccio & Rathod LLP to represent you and the Settlement Class. Class Counsel will petition the Court for a Fee Award of up to 33% (or **\$3,333,333.33**) of the Settlement Fund, plus expenses (subject to Court approval), and a Service Award Payment in the amount of \$2,500 to each Class Representative.

**The Final Fairness Hearing:** The Court has scheduled a hearing for **DATE** at **TIME a.m. ET**, in <<Court Address>>, to consider whether to approve the Settlement and the Application for Attorneys' Fees, Costs and Service Awards, as well as any objections. You or your attorney may request to appear at the hearing, but you are not required to do so.
