WHO IS A CLASS MEMBER?

In the lawsuit *Duggan v. U-Haul International, Inc.*, No. 22-cv-1565 (D. Ariz.), you are a class member if you resided in the State of California during the Data Incidents that U-Haul International Inc. (“U-Haul”) experienced between November 5, 2021 and April 5, 2022, or in December 2023 (the “Settlement Class”) and you previously received a notice of data incident notifying you of either data incident.

WHAT ARE THE SETTLEMENT BENEFITS AND TERMS?

Under the Settlement, U-Haul has agreed to pay \$5,085,000 into a Settlement Fund which will be distributed to Settlement Class Members who submit valid claims, after deducting the Service Awards to the Class Representatives, class counsel’s attorneys’ fees and expenses, and settlement administration notice and administration costs, if such deductions are approved by the Court. All Class Members may submit claims to receive Pro Rata Monetary Payments estimated to be approximately \$100 if 10% of the roughly 259,300-person Settlement Class submit valid claims. Claims for the estimated \$100 payment option will be pro rata adjusted up or down based on the remaining balance of the Settlement Fund after the deduction of settlement administration costs and expenses, attorneys’ fees and expenses, and any class representative service awards. U-Haul has also agreed to implement or continue a series of cybersecurity enhancements to limit the likelihood of a future cyberattack. You must timely submit a valid Claim Form to receive compensation from the \$5,085,000 Settlement Fund. WHAT ARE YOUR RIGHTS AND OPTIONS?

Submit a Claim Form. To qualify for a monetary payment, you must timely mail a Claim Form that is attached to this notice or timely complete and submit a Claim Form online at www.uhauldatasettlement.com (“Settlement Website”). Your Claim Form must be postmarked or submitted online no later than _____, 2024. Kroll Settlement Administration, LLC is the Settlement Administrator.

Opt Out. You may exclude yourself from the settlement and retain your ability to sue U-Haul on your own by mailing a written request for exclusion to the Settlement Administrator that is post marked no later than _____, 2024. If you do not exclude yourself, you will be bound by the settlement and give up your right to sue regarding the released claims.

Object. If you do not exclude yourself, you have the right to object to the settlement. Written objections must be signed, postmarked no later than

_____, 2024, and provide the reasons for the objection. Please visit the Settlement Website for more details.

Do Nothing. If you do nothing, you will not receive a Settlement payment and will lose the right to sue regarding the released claims. You will be bound by the Court’s decision because this is a conditionally certified class action.

Attend the Final Approval Hearing. The Court will hold a **Final Approval Hearing on _____, 2024 at [time]**. All persons who timely object to the settlement by _____, 2024 may appear at the Final Approval Hearing.

Who are the Class Representatives? Michelle Anderson, Saray Hendricks, Peter Telford, Hulises Rolon, Denise Bowen, Bryan Bowen, Mark Johnson, Gerardo Rivera, and Arianna Allen are the Plaintiffs and Class Representatives in this lawsuit. They have remained engaged in representing the Class’s interests during this litigation and reviewed and approved the terms of the proposed Settlement. Each Plaintiff will seek a Service Award of \$2,000.00. There are approximately 259,300 Settlement Class Members whose driver’s license information may have been impacted in U-Haul’s Data Incidents.

Who are the attorneys for the Plaintiffs and the proposed Class? Class Counsel is Terence R. Coates, Markovits, Stock & DeMarco, LLC.

Do I have any obligation to pay attorneys’ fees or expenses? No. The attorneys’ fees and expenses will be paid exclusively from the Settlement Fund as awarded and approved by the Court. The attorneys’ fees will be in an amount not to exceed 30% of the \$5,085,000 Settlement Fund (*i.e.* no more than \$1,525,500) and the expenses will not exceed \$70,000. The motion for attorneys’ fees and expenses will be posted on the Settlement Website after it is filed with the Court.

When is the Final Approval Hearing? The final approval hearing, where the Court will determine if the settlement is fair, reasonable, and adequate, will be conducted on _____ 2024 at [time].
