Defendant HP, Inc. ("HP") hereby provides this notice of proposed Settlement of the above-captioned class action lawsuit (the "Action") pursuant to the Class Action Fairness Act of 2005, 28 U.S.C. § 1715 ("CAFA").

On December 2, 2024, Plaintiffs in the Action, currently pending in the United States District Court for the Northern District of California, filed with the Court a Motion for Preliminary Approval of Class Action Settlement and materials in support thereof. Among the supporting materials is the copy of the Class Action Settlement Agreement and Release between Plaintiffs Rodney Carvalho and Mark Maher, on the one hand, and HP, on the other, signed on December 12, 2024 (the "Proposed Settlement Agreement").

On December 2, 2024, Plaintiff filed a Motion for Preliminary Approval of Class Action Settlement. A hearing to consider preliminary approval of the Proposed Settlement is scheduled for January 16, 2025, at 10:00 a.m. in the Courtroom of the Honorable P. Casey Pitts, United States District Judge for the Northern District of California, located at 280 South 1st Street, San Jose, California 95113 (Exhibit 4).

Proposed class Notices were submitted to the Court on December 2, 2024 along with Plaintiff's Motion for Preliminary Approval of Class Action Settlement as Attachments A and B to the Settlement Agreement. The proposed class notices contain information about the claim submission process and the Settlement Class Members' rights to object or request exclusion from the class action.

5. 28 U.S.C. § 1715(b)(5): Other Contemporaneous Agreements

No other contemporaneous agreements were made or contemplated with respect to the Proposed Settlement Agreement.

6. 28 U.S.C. § 1715(b)(6): Final Judgments

At this time, there have been no final judgments or dismissals related to the Proposed Settlement Agreement.

7. 28 U.S.C. § 1715(b)(7): Class Member Names and States of Residence

The Settlement Class definition in the Proposed Settlement Agreement is individuals nationwide who purchased an HP product, identified in the Proposed Settlement Agreement, during the period from June 5, 2021 to October 28, 2024.

Because there are 287,784 individuals in the Settlement Class, it is not feasible to identify all of them. The approximate percentage of the Settlement Class Members residing in each state is as follows:
