TO ALL PERSONS WHO, WHILE RESIDING IN CALIFORNIA, SIGNED UP FOR A SUBSCRIPTION TO MUBI ON OR AFTER APRIL 1, 2021 THAT WAS RENEWED BETWEEN APRIL 1, 2021 AND MAY 31, 2025, AND WHO DID NOT RECEIVE A REFUND OF ALL SUBSCRIPTION RENEWAL CHARGES.

Read this notice carefully. You could receive compensation from this Class Action Settlement. This court-authorized notice describes your rights and gives information about the proposed settlement. This notice is only a summary. Details of the settlement are available at [Settlement Website] or by writing to or calling the Settlement Administrator at the address or toll-free number below.

What Is This Case About?

In the lawsuit entitled *Cesar Cejudo v. MUBI, Inc.*, Case No. 5:25-CV-03652-BLF, filed in the United States District Court for the Northern District of California, Plaintiff Cesar Cejudo (“Plaintiff” or “Class Representative”), on behalf of himself and a proposed Class, alleges that Defendant, a global streaming service, production company, and film distributor, failed to provide consumers with adequate notice that its subscriptions automatically renewed, and failed to seek sufficient consent to the renewals. Defendant disputes these allegations and denies any wrongdoing. The lawsuit seeks money damages, as well as attorneys’ fees and costs. The Court has not ruled on the merits of the claims or Defendant’s defenses.

Who Is A Settlement Class Member?

Settlement Class Members include all persons who, while a resident of California, signed up for a subscription with MUBI, Inc. (“MUBI”) on or after April 1, 2021 and had his or her subscription to MUBI renewed between April 1, 2021 and May 31, 2025, and who did not receive a refund from MUBI of all subscription renewal charges.

What Are The Terms Of The Settlement?

To settle the Action, MUBI has agreed to pay a non-reversionary fund of \$1,600,000 (the “Settlement Fund”). The Settlement Fund will be primarily used to provide cash awards, paid by check or electronic payment, to each Settlement Class Member who submits a valid Claim Form (“Cash Settlement Award”) by [Claim Deadline]. The Settlement Fund will also be used to pay for notice and administration costs estimated to be [Estimate], an incentive award of up to \$5,000 to the Class Representative, reasonable attorneys’ fees of no more than 25% of the Settlement Fund, and the reasonable costs sustained by Class Counsel in litigating and settling this case.

To receive a Cash Settlement Award, Settlement Class Members must submit a valid Claim Form, as instructed below. Settlement Class Members who submit a valid and timely Claim Form will receive an equal portion of the Settlement Fund after deducting the other costs and fees described above. The exact amount that Settlement Class Members receive will depend on the number of valid Claim Forms submitted.

How Do You Receive Your Cash Settlement Award?

To receive a Cash Settlement Award, you must submit a signed and completed Claim Form online to the Class Action Settlement Administrator by **no later than [Claim Deadline]**. Claim Forms may also be submitted to the Settlement Administrator by mail to [\[Address\]](#) if postmarked **no later than [Claim Deadline]**. The Claim Form is available at [\[Settlement Website\]](#). If you do not submit a timely and valid Claim Form, you will not receive a Cash Settlement Award.

What Are My Other Options?

If you do not want to be legally bound by the Settlement, you may opt out of the Settlement by sending a request for exclusion through a written statement to the Settlement Administrator **no later than [Objection/Exclusion Deadline]**. If you exclude yourself from the Settlement, you will not receive a Cash Settlement Award from the Settlement. If you do not opt out of the Settlement, you will be bound by any judgment approving the Settlement and will give up any right to sue Defendant for any claims under federal and state law that are based on or arise from the allegations concerning Defendant's automatic renewal of MUBI subscriptions in this Action during the Class Period, April 1, 2021 to May 31, 2025.

If you stay in the Settlement (i.e., do not exclude yourself from the Settlement), you may object to the Settlement by writing to the Court explaining why you do not like the Settlement by **no later than [Objection/Exclusion Deadline]**. The Court can only approve or deny the Settlement and cannot change the terms of the Settlement. You will be bound by the Settlement if your objection is rejected and will still receive a Cash Settlement Award if you submit a valid Claim Form. Final Approval Hearing

The Court will hold a hearing in this case to consider whether to approve the Settlement on [\[Fairness Hearing Date\]](#), at [\[Fairness Hearing Time\]](#), in Courtroom 1 on the 5th Floor of the San Jose Division of the United States District Court for the Northern District of California, located at 280 South 1st Street, San Jose, CA 95113. The date of the Final Approval Hearing may change without further notice to the class. Settlement Class Members should be advised to check the Settlement Website or the Court's PACER site (accessible for a fee at <https://ecf.cand.uscourts.gov>) to confirm that the date has not been changed and whether the hearing may be held virtually.
