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**What is this Case About?** In this lawsuit, Plaintiff alleges that Defendant MUBI, Inc. ("MUBI"), a global streaming service, production company, and film distributor, failed to provide consumers with adequate notice that its subscriptions automatically renewed and failed to seek sufficient consent to the renewals. Defendant disputes the allegations and denies any wrongdoing. You are receiving this Notice because Defendant's records indicate that you may be a Settlement Class Member. Settlement Class Members include consumers who, while residents of California, had their subscription to MUBI renewed between April 1, 2021 and May 31, 2025, and did not receive a refund of all subscription renewal charges.

**What are the Settlement Benefits?** To settle the Action, MUBI has agreed to pay a non-reversionary fund of \$1,600,000 (the "Settlement Fund"). The Settlement Fund will be primarily used to provide cash awards, paid by check or electronic payment, to each Settlement Class Member who submits a valid claim form ("Cash Settlement Award"). The Settlement Fund will also be used to pay for notice and administration costs estimated to be **(\$Estimate)**, an incentive award of up to \$5,000 to the Class Representative, reasonable attorneys' fees of no more than 25% of the Settlement Fund, and the reasonable costs sustained by Class Counsel in litigating and settling this case. **How do I Receive a Cash Settlement Award?** To receive a Cash Settlement Award, Settlement Class Members must submit a signed and completed Claim Form online to the Settlement Administrator by **no later than [Claim Deadline]**. Claim Forms may also be submitted to the Class Action Settlement Administrator by mail, if postmarked **no later than [Claim Deadline]**. Settlement Class Members who submit a valid and timely Claim Form will receive an equal portion of the Settlement Fund after deducting the other costs and fees described above. The exact amount that Settlement Class Members receive will depend on the number of valid Claim Forms submitted. The Claim Form is available at [\[Settlement Website\]](#). If you do not submit a timely and valid Claim Form, you will not receive a Cash Settlement Award.

**What are my Other Options?** If you do nothing, you will not receive a Cash Settlement Award, will be legally bound by the terms of the Settlement, and will release your certain claims against Defendant. If you do not want to be legally bound by the Settlement, you may opt out of the Settlement by writing to the Settlement Administrator by [\[Objection/Exclusion Deadline\]](#). If you opt-out, you will not receive a Cash Settlement Award from the Settlement. If you do not opt-out, you can object to the Settlement by writing to the Court by [\[Objection/Exclusion Deadline\]](#). **The Court's Final Approval Hearing.** The Court will hold a hearing in this case to consider whether to approve the Settlement on [\[Fairness Hearing Date\]](#) at [\[Fairness Hearing Time\]](#), in Courtroom 1 on the 5th Floor of the San Jose Division of the United States District Court for the Northern District of California, located at 280 South 1st Street, San Jose, CA 95113.
