Nevertheless, Defendant highly values its employees and has chosen to settle this matter and make settlement payments to its employees and former employees instead of incurring further disruption and expense in this litigation. Defendant has not admitted to any liability by entering into this Settlement. Who is Included? You received this Notice because Defendant's records indicate you are likely a Settlement Class member.

The Settlement Class includes all individuals residing in the United States whose Private Information may have been impacted in the Data Incident, including those who were sent a notice by Defendant that their Private Information may have been impacted in the Data Incident. What does the Settlement Provide? Settlement Class members may be able to receive the following Settlement Class Member Benefits by filing a timely and valid Claim Form online or by mail postmarked by Month XX, 20YY:
