A proposed Settlement has been reached in a class action lawsuit known as *In Re San Francisco 49ers Data Breach Litigation*, Case No. 3:22-CV-05138-JD ("Litigation"), filed in the United States District Court for the Northern District of California, San Francisco Division.

What is this about? This Litigation alleges that on February 6, 2022, cybercriminals bypassed the 49ers' security systems undetected and accessed PII as part of a ransomware attack ("Data Incident"). Plaintiffs further allege that, as a result of the Data Incident, the criminals gained access to Plaintiffs' and other consumers' personal information, including but not limited to name, date of birth, and Social Security Number (collectively, "PII"). The 49ers disagrees with Plaintiffs' claims and deny any wrongdoing.

Who is a Settlement Class Member? You are a Settlement Class Member if you were mailed notice by the 49ers that your PII was impacted in a data incident occurring between February 6, 2022 and February 11, 2022.

What are the benefits? The settlement provides the following benefits:

- Out-of-Pocket Expense Reimbursement: All Settlement Class Members who have suffered a proven monetary loss and who submit a Valid Claim using the Claim Form are eligible for up to \$7,500, incurred as a result of the Data Incident;
- *Pro Rata* Cash Payment: The remainder amount of the Settlement Fund allocated for Settlement Class Member benefits will be distributed to Settlement Class Members on a *pro rata* basis, except that each California Settlement Subclass Member shall be allocated three shares of the Settlement Remainder. No claim needs to be filed to receive this payment.
- **Information Security Improvements**: The 49ers will also implement certain reasonable steps to adequately secure its systems and environment.

How do I make a claim? You must file a Claim Form to obtain Out-of-Pocket Expense Reimbursement by mail postmarked by <<Claims Deadline>>, and mailed to the Claim Administrator's address below, or online at www.website.com by <Claims Deadline>, to receive compensation from the settlement.

What are my other rights?

Do Nothing: If you do nothing, you remain in the settlement. You give up your rights to sue but you will not get any money; you must submit a claim to get any money.

Exclude yourself: You can get out of the settlement and keep your right to sue the 49ers related to the Data Incident, but you will not receive any compensation from the settlement. You must submit a valid and timely request for exclusion to the Claims Administrator by <Opt-Out Date>>.

Object: You can stay in the settlement but tell the Court why you think the settlement should not be approved. Objections must be submitted by [Objection Date]. Detailed instructions on how to file a claim, get additional credit monitoring, exclude yourself, or object are on the Settlement Website below. The Court will hold the Final Fairness Hearing at <Opate>> at <Time>> a.m. PT to consider whether the proposed settlement is fair, reasonable, and adequate, to consider attorneys' fees up to twenty-five percent (25%) of the Settlement Fund (\$152,500), costs and expenses, and a service award of \$2,500 to each named Representative Plaintiff in this Litigation, and to consider whether and if it should be approved. You may attend this hearing but are not required to. The date may change without further notice to the Settlement Class, so please check
