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A settlement has been reached in a class action lawsuit concerning a Data Incident perpetrated against Defendant Golden Corral Corporation. The Litigation alleges that, on August 15, 2023, Golden Corral was targeted in a cyberattack by an unknown third party. Plaintiffs allege that this cyberattack exposed certain personally identifiable information of Golden Corral's current and former employees, and certain non-employees. Specifically, the following types of Private Information were allegedly exposed: names, Social Security Numbers, financial account details, driver's license numbers, medical information, usernames and passwords, and health insurance information. On February 16, 2024, Golden Corral began notifying Plaintiffs and the Settlement Class about the Data Incident. Defendant denies any wrongdoing whatsoever.

Who is included in the settlement?

The Settlement Class is defined by the Court as "all individuals impacted by the Data Incident that occurred between August 11, 2023, and August 16, 2023, who were sent a notice of the Data Incident." Excluded from the Settlement Class are (1) the judges presiding over this Litigation, and members of their direct families; (2) Golden Corral, its subsidiaries, parent companies, successors, predecessors, and any entity in which Golden Corral or its parents have a controlling interest, and its current or former officers and directors; and (3) Settlement Class Members who submit a valid request for exclusion prior to **<the Opt-Out Deadline>**.

What are the settlement benefits? The settlement provides the following Settlement Payments to Settlement Class Members who submit Approved Claims: (a) Compensation for Unreimbursed Economic Losses, up to \$10,000 per Settlement Class Member, with supporting documentation; or (b) a Pro Rata Cash Payment—an estimated \$50 Settlement Payment (that may increase or decrease based on the number of Approved Claims and remaining Settlement Funds). How do I receive a payment or other benefit? To receive a payment under the settlement, you **MUST** submit a claim. To submit a claim, you may either: (i) fill out, detach, and mail the attached Claim Form to the Settlement Administrator; or (ii) submit a Claim Form by mail or online at www.website.com. You may also call (XXX) XXX-XXXX to request that a Claim Form be mailed to you. **Claims must be submitted online or by mail postmarked by <Claims Deadline>**.

What are my other options? If you **Do Nothing**, you will be legally bound by the terms of the settlement, and you will release your claims against the Defendant and other Released Parties as defined in the Settlement Agreement. If you do not want to be legally bound by the settlement, you must **Exclude Yourself** by **<Opt-Out Deadline>**, or you will not be able to sue the Defendant or any other Released Parties for Released Claims relating to the Data Incident. If you exclude yourself, you cannot get a Settlement Payment from this settlement. If you want to **Object** to the settlement, you may file an objection by **<Objection Deadline>**. The Long Form Notice, posted on the Settlement Website,

explains how to submit a Claim Form, exclude yourself, or object.

Do I have a lawyer in this Case?

Yes, the Court appointed Gary M. Klinger of Milberg Coleman Bryson Phillips Grossman PLLC, as Class Counsel for the Settlement Class. If you want to be represented by your own lawyer, you may hire one at your own expense.

When will the Court decide whether to approve the Settlement? The Court will hold a hearing in this case on **<DATE> at <TIME> a.m./ET**, at the United States District Court for the Eastern District of North Carolina, Alton Lennon Federal Building and Courthouse, 2 Princess Street, Wilmington, NC 28401, to consider whether to approve the settlement. The Court will also consider Class Counsel's Fee and Expense Application for attorneys' fees not to exceed 33.33% of the value of the settlement, i.e., \$610,500, and litigation expenses up to \$20,000 for negotiating the settlement on behalf of the Settlement Class, and Service Awards of \$2,500 to each of the Plaintiffs (\$15,000 total). You may attend the hearing, but you do not have to.
