WHO IS A CLASS MEMBER?

In the lawsuit *In Re: Houser Data Breach Litigation*, No. 8:24-cv-00468–WLH-ADS (C.D. Cal.), you are a Settlement Class Member if you received a notice of the Houser Data Incident that occurred between approximately May 7, 2023 and May 9, 2023 (the “Settlement Class”). If you live in California, you likely are a member of the California Subclass.

WHAT ARE THE SETTLEMENT BENEFITS AND TERMS?

Houser, LLP (“Houser”) has agreed to pay \$1,300,000 into a Settlement Fund which will be distributed to Settlement Class Members who submit Valid Claims, after deducting the Class Representative Service Awards, Class Counsel’s Attorneys’ Fees and Expenses Award, and Costs of Claims Administration, if approved by the Court. All Settlement Class Members may submit Claim Forms to receive **\$50** (subject to *pro rata* increase or reduction) plus up to **\$5,000** (subject to *pro rata* reduction) for reimbursement of out-of-pocket expenses or losses caused by the Data Incident. California Subclass members may claim an **additional \$100 payment** (subject to *pro rata* reduction) and Washington California Subclass members may claim an **additional \$25 payment** (subject to *pro rata* reduction).. More information about the types of Settlement Claims and required information to file them is available at www.XXX.com (“Settlement Website”). Houser has also agreed to maintain a series of cybersecurity enhancements.

WHAT ARE YOUR RIGHTS AND OPTIONS?

Submit a Claim Form. To qualify for a cash payment you must mail a Claim Form that is attached to this notice or submit a Claim Form online at the Settlement Website. Your Claim Form must be postmarked or submitted online by **2025**, **2025** is the Claims Administrator.

Opt Out. You may exclude yourself from the Settlement and retain your ability to sue Houser on your own by mailing a written request for exclusion to the Claims Administrator postmarked no later than **2025**, **2025**. If you don’t exclude yourself, you’ll be bound by the Settlement and give up your right to sue regarding the settled claims.

Object. If you do not exclude yourself, you have the right to object to the Settlement. Written objections must be signed, postmarked no later than **2025**, **2025**, and provide the reasons for the objection. Please visit the Settlement Website

for more requirements.

Do Nothing. If you do nothing, you will not receive a Settlement payment and will lose the right to sue regarding any issues relating to this action. You will be bound by the Court’s decisions because this is a conditionally certified class action.

Attend the Final Approval Hearing. The Court will hold a **Final Approval Hearing on** **2025** at [time]. All persons who timely object to the Settlement by **2025** may appear at the Final Approval Hearing.

Who are the Class Representatives? Richard McMillen, Joseph Kausse, Mark Giannelli, Scott Miller, and Karie Simmons are the Class Representatives in this lawsuit. They will seek service awards of \$2,000.

Who are the attorneys for the Class Representatives and the proposed Class? Class Counsel includes John J. Nelson of Milberg Coleman Bryson Phillips Grossman and Joseph M. Lyon of The Lyon Firm. These attorneys are well known and respected by courts and counsel throughout the United States for handling class actions, such as this one.

Do I have any obligation to pay attorneys’ fees or expenses? No. The Attorneys’ Fees and Expense Award will be paid exclusively by Houser as awarded and approved by the Court, and will not exceed 1/3 of the Settlement Fund. The motion for Attorneys’ Fees and Expense Award will be posted on the Settlement Website after it is filed with the Court.

When is the Final Approval Hearing? The Final Approval Hearing, where the Court will determine if the Settlement is fair, reasonable, and adequate, will be conducted on **2025** at [time].

Who is the Judge overseeing this Settlement? District Judge Wesley L. Hsu.
