A settlement has been proposed in a class action lawsuit against Crystal Bay Casino, LLC ("Defendant" or "Crystal Bay") relating to the potential unauthorized access of personal information to an unauthorized third party that occurred in November 2022 as part of a ransomware attack ("Data Security Incident"). Defendant denies all liability.

**Who is included?** Crystal Bay's records indicate that you are included in the Settlement. The Settlement Class includes all individuals that received notice from Crystal Bay in or around February 2023, of a data security incident involving their Personal Information. ("Settlement Class Members").

What does the Settlement provide? The Settlement provides Settlement Class Members with the right to claim 3-years of credit monitoring. In addition, Settlement Class Members may choose to claim (1) compensation for documented ordinary losses (up to \$500), compensation for lost time (up to 5 hours at \$20 per hour), and documented extraordinary losses (up to \$10,000) <u>or</u> (2) a cash payment instead of all the other monetary benefits.

**How do I get benefits?** You must complete and submit a Claim Form by **Month \_\_\_, 2024**. Claim Forms are available and may be filed online at <u>www.[website].com</u>. Claim Forms may also be printed from the website or requested by calling the Claims Administrator and submitted by mail postmarked by Month \_\_\_, 2024.

What are my other options? If you do not want to be legally bound by the Settlement, you must exclude yourself by Month \_\_\_, 2024. Unless you exclude yourself from the Settlement, you will not be able to sue Sandridge or its related parties for any claim released by the Settlement Agreement. If you do not exclude yourself from the Settlement, you may object and notify the Court that you or your lawyer intend to appear at the Court's fairness hearing. Objections are due Month \_\_\_, 2024.

**The Court's Fairness Hearing.** The Court will hold a final fairness hearing in this case (*Mendoza et al. v. Crystal Bay Casino, LLC*, No. 3:23-cv-00092) on Month \_\_, 2024, at \_\_:\_0 \_.m. at the US District Court in Reno, Nevada. At this hearing, the Court will decide whether to approve: (1) the Settlement; (2) Class Counsel's request for up to \$225,000 in attorneys' fees, and reimbursement of costs; and (3) \$1,000 Service Awards to each Class Representative. You may appear at the hearing, but you do not have to. You also may hire your own attorney, at your own expense, to appear or speak for you at the hearing.
