You have been identified as a potential “Settlement Class Member” from State Farm’s claims data, because you were a Louisiana policyholder and insured by State Farm entity and submitted a covered first-party private passenger auto physical damage claim during the period commencing from May 17, 2022 through _____, 2026 (“Class Period”) that resulted in a total loss claim payment from State Farm which did not include full Purchasing Fees.

The Settlement resolves a lawsuit claiming that State Farm breached its auto insurance policies by failing to pay full Purchasing Fees to insureds who submitted Louisiana first-party total loss auto claims. State Farm denies any fault, wrongdoing or liability.

State Farm will pay Settlement Class Members \$28.39 in satisfaction of applicable Purchasing Fees to eligible Settlement Class Members who timely submit a valid claim. The Court will hear objections, determine if the Settlement is fair, and consider Class Counsel’s request for Attorney’s Fees and Costs of \$205,000.00, and Service Award of \$5,000.00 to the Class Representative. The attorneys’ fees, costs and service award will not reduce the amount of money available to Settlement Class Members.

To be eligible for payment, you must either (a) complete and mail the Claim Form attached to the postcard you received in the mail or (b) submit a Claim Form online at www.XXXX.com by using the above link and Claimant ID information. Claim Forms must be postmarked or submitted online by 11:59 pm EST on _____, 20__.

Unless you submit a Claim Form, you will not be eligible to get a Settlement Class Payment and your rights will be affected. If you don't want to be legally bound by the settlement, pursuant to which you will be giving a release of any claims asserted in the lawsuit, you must exclude yourself from it by [MONTH], [DAY], [YEAR]. Unless you exclude yourself, you won't be able to sue or continue to sue State Farm for any claim made in this lawsuit or released by the Settlement Agreement. If you stay in the Settlement (i.e., don't exclude yourself), you may object to it or ask for permission for you or your own lawyer to appear and speak at the hearing— at your own cost— but you don't have to. Objections and requests to appear, which must comply with the procedures for such submissions, are due by [MONTH], [DAY], [YEAR]. Any notice of intent to object or intervene must contain the following: (a) the name of this Action; (b) the objector's full name, address and telephone number; (c) all grounds for the objection, accompanied by any legal support for the objection known to the objector or objector's counsel; (d) the number of times the objector has objected to a class action settlement within the five years preceding the date that the objector files the objection, the caption of each case in which the objector has made such objection, and a copy of any orders related to or ruling upon the objector's prior objections that were issued by the trial and appellate courts in each listed case; (e) the identity of all counsel who represent the objector, including any former or current counsel who may be entitled to compensation for any reason related to the objection to the Settlement or fee application; (f) the number of times in which objector's counsel and/or counsel's law firm have objected to a class action settlement within the five years preceding the date that objector filed the objection, the caption of each case in which counsel or the firm has made such objection and a copy of any orders related to or ruling upon counsel's or the counsel's law firm's prior objections that were issued by the trial and appellate courts in each listed case in which the objector's counsel and/or counsel's law firm have objected to a class action settlement within the preceding five years; (g) any and all agreements that relate to the objection or the process of objecting—whether written or oral—between objector or objector's counsel and any other person or entity; (h) the identity of all counsel (if any) representing the objector who will appear at the Final Approval Hearing; (i) a list of all persons who will be called to testify at the Final Approval Hearing in support of the objection; (j) a statement confirming whether the objector intends to personally appear and/or testify at the Final Approval Hearing; and (k) the objector's signature (an attorney's signature is not sufficient).
